We have exciting news! Thanks to all of our amazing donors, enough funds were raised to purchase the property located at 3859 W. Nichols for our future Rescue One Center! We received the results from the environment study and were given the green light to move forward with the project. At a time where pet homelessness is rapidly increasing in our community, this growth could not come at a better time.

Our main focus with this new project is to help fill in the gaps for animals in need in our community by expanding our emergency rescue, SafePet, and TNR programs as well as offering the community's first low cost veterinary clinic to help pet owners on limited incomes provide much needed care for there animals.

There are already animal shelters who service the community and are usually at capacity. This will NOT be an animal shelter but will have boarding kennels to temporarily hold animals picked up through our emergency rescue program until foster homes can be found or they are reclaimed. It would be impossible to build a shelter big enough for all of the animals in need in our area. We must get to the root of the issue by providing education, spay and neuter assistance, and low cost vet care. This clinic will be targeting those who currently can't afford care and to become a client there will be income qualifications and all pets must be spayed or neutered. If they are not, we can do so at our clinic. **We know many people think if someone can not afford a pet, they shouldn't have a pet. Regardless, they will still have pets and no pet deserves to suffer.**

We are working on a capital campaign that will be launched in 2022 to make this vision a reality. We hope we can count on your support when that time comes!



This 14,000 sft. building will be the home to all of Rescue One's operations. We currently operate out of a small clinic that can only accommodate the animals in our care due to space. We also have a supply office that has 4 emergency kennels. This new building will allow us to reach more animals in our community by providing much needed resources and medical care.

Highlights included in the building plans are 17 spacious rooms with outdoor access during the day for behavioral and emergency dog boarding, staff offices, 2 meet and greet rooms, 4 community cat rooms with catios, cat intake room, space for adoption events, photo shoots and training, warehouse for supplies, a 4,000 sqf veterinary clinic that will accommodate multiple veterinarians, hospitalization kennels for animals in our care, isolation areas, exam rooms, lab, xray/diagnostic room, pharmacy, and a spacious surgery suite with 3 tables.

After years of neglect, help came.


Meet Lucille



Lucille came to us from a neglect case in Christian County where she was living on a chain. Unable to escape standing water, she developed a severe skin infection. When she arrived at our clinic, she was so weak she could not stand. We got to work shaving the mats from her skin to see what damage had been done. We quickly learned that she was infested with maggots. Once all of the maggots were removed, she was started on antibiotics and pain medication. After weeks of medication, laser treatments, good food, and love, Lucille was feeling and looking great! She is now living the life she deserves in her new forever home!

After my owner died, I was shot.

Meet Tip



On a Sunday afternoon we received a call about an injured dog. The caller stated he had been shot by a family member due to his owner passing away. Our team headed out and found a confused dog in pain and rushed him to the emergency vet. Xrays showed his body was riddled with birdshot. He spent several days hospitalized and had to have his eye removed due to damage from the fragments. He was sent for an orthopedic consult where his leg was debrided of as many of the fragments as possible and it was determined he would get to keep his leg! He is still in foster care recovering and will hopefully find his forever home soon!
